PLANNING QUESTIONS

- What decision should this survey or feedback project support?
- Which audience can give reliable feedback about survey security, survey bots, online survey scams, cheating prevention, data quality, and trustworthy response collection?
- What would a useful answer help you improve, compare, or explain?

QUESTION IDEAS

- What matters most to you when thinking about survey security, survey bots, online survey scams, cheating prevention, data quality, and trustworthy response collection?
- What has been difficult, unclear, or missing in your experience?
- What should we change first, and why?





AI prompt ideas for survey security

Use these with your preferred AI tool to create a first draft, then edit the output for your audience, brand voice, privacy needs, and the real decision your survey should support.

BEFORE YOU USE THEM

- Replace bracketed details with your audience, survey channel, timing, and main decision.
- Ask for plain language, neutral wording, and a useful mix of rating, multiple-choice, and open-ended questions.
- Review every output before publishing so the survey feels human and the answers will be useful.

COPY-READY PROMPT IDEAS

- Create a survey plan for [audience] about survey security. The goal is [decision or learning goal]. Include the best question types, answer scales, and what each question should help us learn.
- Create 12 clear survey questions about survey security, survey bots, online survey scams, cheating prevention, data quality, and trustworthy response collection. Include rating, multiple-choice, and open-ended questions, and avoid leading or biased wording.

From category to action

FIVE-STEP WORKFLOW

- Start with one decision or learning goal, not a loose list of questions.
- Choose the audience segment that can answer from real experience.
- Use closed questions for comparison and open-ended questions for context.
- Group answers by patterns such as needs, objections, behaviors, and priorities.
- Turn the strongest pattern into an improvement, test, message, or follow-up survey.

QUALITY CHECKLIST

- Can someone act on the finding without reading every raw response?
- Do you know which audience group the finding applies to?
- Does the result connect back to the original decision?
